

## The Missing UH's

In 1980 Schrade produced a new knife which they initially named the I.V.L.B. which in fact was the LB4. The knife was produced until 1985 with a total of 5107 knives being shipped.

In 1983 Schrade introduced a pattern line called the "3<sup>Rd</sup> Generation" consisting of 7 knives one of which was the C641 built on the same frame as the I.V.L.B. I cannot find any I.V.L.B. having been built that year.

In 1984 Schrade made 2 new UH knives, the 707UH and the 892UH, in very low numbers. These were produced for only 2 years each being built on an existing 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation frame. The 707UH was later released in 1991 in a completely different configuration with a single blade and a small scissor.
