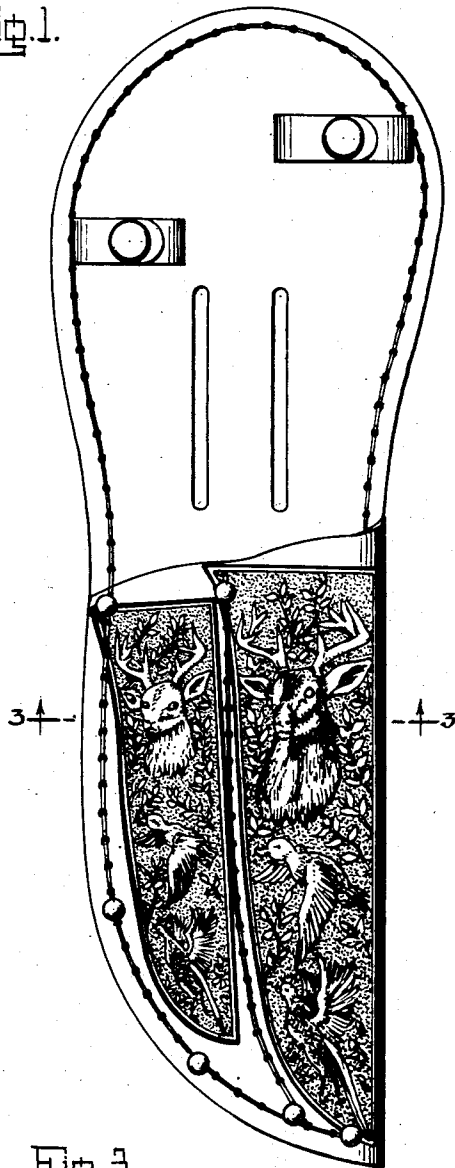

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Theodore G. Schrade, a citizen of the United States and resident of Nichols, Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Hunting Knife Sheath, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

In the drawings:

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of the hunting knife sheath, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation; and

Fig. 3 is a sectional view taken along the line 3—3 of Fig. 1.
