National Knife Collectors Association 1981 Club Knife

At the Louisville, Kentucky Knife Show on April 26, 1980, the NKCA Board of Directors met to select the club's 1981 club knife from the many submitted by several knife manufacturers.

Chosen by the majority vote of the Board was the knife pictured at left. The knife will be made for the club by Queen Cutlery Company of Titusville, PA. A large "Bullhead" pattern, the knife will have two blades with appropriate NKCA club knife etching on the master blade. As with the prototype knife shown at left, the handles will be genuine stag; however, the club knife's handle will have a shield.

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QUEEN POLICY IS DEDICATED TO OUR RETAIL DEALERS

Mark-Ups and Gross Profits

Few terms are more misunderstood than "Mark-Up" and "Gross Profit."

You can go broke by failing to know their meaning.

MARK-UP is the percentage of the amount you earn on the **COST** of an item you sell.

GROSS PROFIT is the percentage of the amount you earn on the **SELLING PRICE** of the item.

MARK-UP — HOW TO COMPUTE IT:

A product costs you \$5.00. You sell it for \$7.50 — \$2.50 above cost. Divide cost (\$5.00) into your earnings (\$2.50). You get 50%. That is your mark-up on cost.

GROSS PROFIT — HOW TO COMPUTE IT:

The same product costs you \$5.00. Again you sell it for \$7.50 — \$2.50 above cost. Divide selling price (\$7.50) into your earnings (\$2.50) and you get a percentage of $33\frac{1}{3}$. That is your gross profit on selling price.

From the above you will note that 50% added to the cost results in $33\frac{1}{3}$ % profit on selling price.

The table below shows the percentages over cost of $66\frac{2}{3}$ % to 100%, which is the recommended Queen resale price range. We trust you will find this a valuable aid when repricing merchandise on displays you already have, or when ordering a new display.

MARK-UP AND GROSS PROFIT

66 $\frac{2}{3}$ %	added to cost is	40.03%	profit on selling price
70 %	added to cost is	41.18%	profit on selling price
75 %	added to cost is	42.86%	profit on selling price
80 %	added to cost is	44.45%	profit on selling price
85 %	added to cost is	45.95%	profit on selling price
90 %	added to cost is	47.37%	profit on selling price
95 %	added to cost is	48.72%	profit on selling price
100 %	added to cost is	50.00%	profit on selling price

Some manufacturers, in an effort to sell their product without regard to your store's profit, encourage price cutting. We are interested in your well being. Think before you cut your price. Can you sell enough more units to make it pay?

If you are selling a product at a present gross profit of 40%, and you cut your price by 5%, you must sell 14.3 more UNITS to get the same number of dollars. If the selling price is reduced 10% you must sell $33\frac{1}{3}$ more UNITS; 20% twice as many UNITS.

Take a fair mark-up. Offer your customers good quality at a reasonable price. You will profit, your customer will profit, and we at Queen hope to profit with you.
