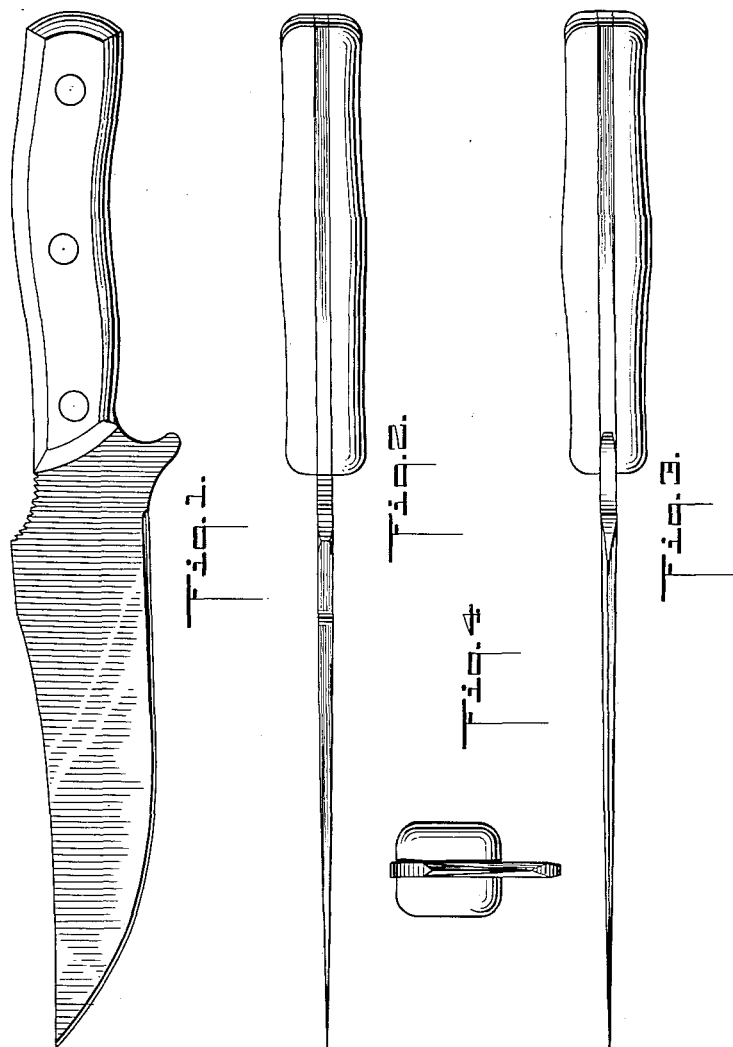


FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a hunting knife, showing my new design; and
